### Challenge

Andrea Bell, an academic specialist in Greenville County Schools, explored Walkabouts' efficacy in supporting Pre-K to 2nd grade teachers and students.

When Bell joined GCS, Walkabouts were available to their 53 Pre-K and elementary campuses. Her role was to advocate for health and wellness initiatives across GCS, including integrating movement-based learning in classrooms, and offering professional development.

### Solution
